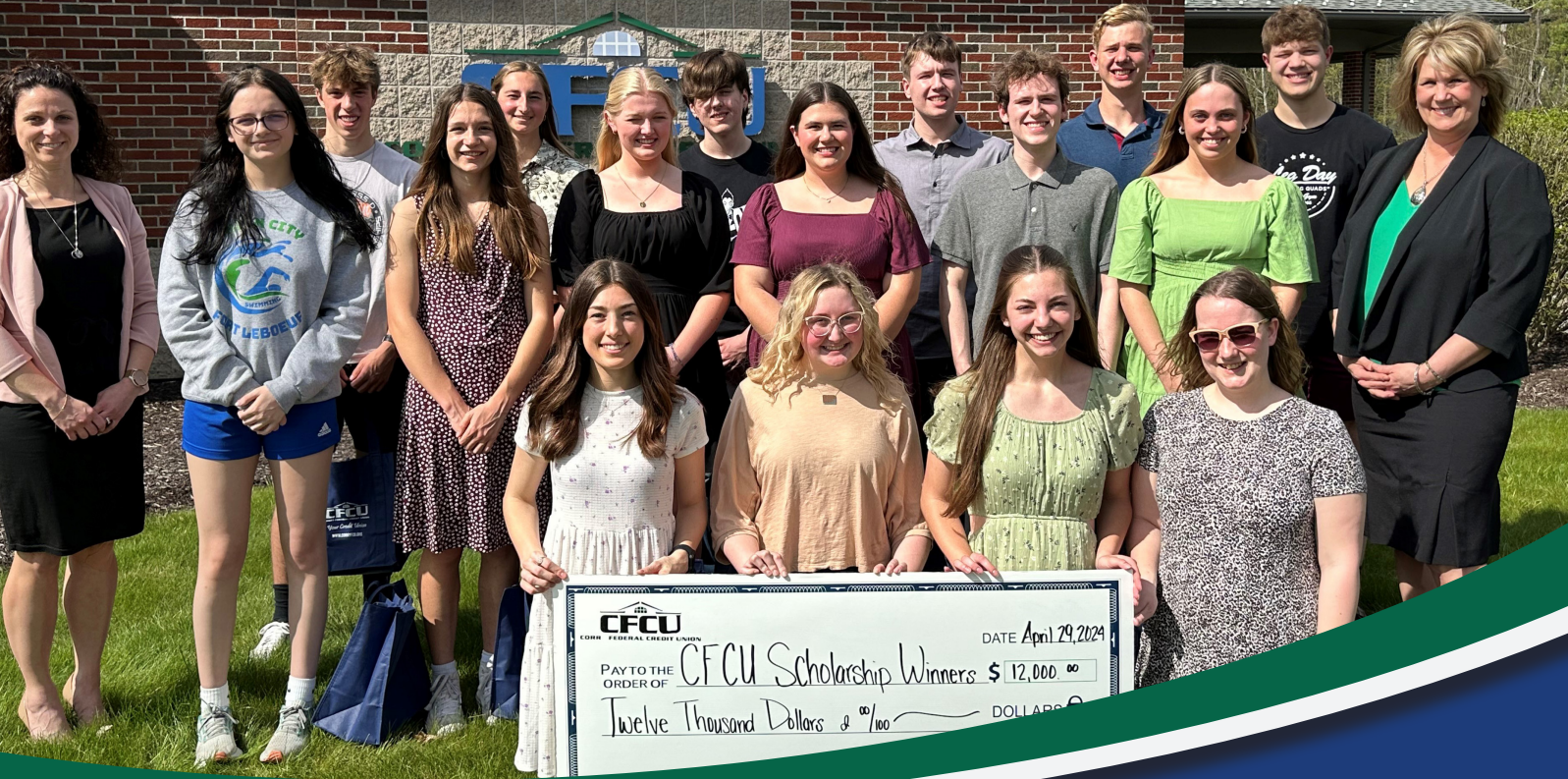

Corry Federal Credit Union is presenting local, post-secondary education bound high school seniors with the opportunity to compete for one of our scholarships. In the past, we have raised enough money for eight scholarships ranging from \$1,500 to \$500. It's a simple three step process, making this an opportunity you cannot pass up.

There is no fee for submitting the application, but those students applying **MUST** be members of the Corry Federal Credit Union and **MUST** be a post-secondary education bound high school senior. If you are not a member, please stop in either location to sign up and learn about how we are unlike any other financial institution. Completed applications are due back to any Corry Federal Credit Union location by **Friday, March 28, 2025, by 6:00pm**. After which, applications will undergo evaluation by an external and impartial entity to ensure a fair and unbiased competition. **If any application is incomplete, it will automatically be disqualified, regardless of the judges' scores.** The winners will be announced and contacted in early May and funds will be disbursed.

Scholarship Requirements

The Award:

CFCU will give away multiple awards this year, ranging in value from \$1,500 to \$500, to be paid directly to the member's chosen educational institution.

Eligibility:

The applicant must be a member in good standing of CFCU. The member must be a post-secondary education-bound high school senior at the time of application. Scholarship funds must be used (1) for tuition, (2) only at an accredited educational institution, and (3) by January 31, 2026.

Application Process:

Eligible members are asked to complete this scholarship application. Applications MUST be finished by the applicant themselves and will not be considered if a parent and/or guardian completes it for them.

Check these spaces for your own reference after competition of each step.

___ The application must be signed by a CFCU employee after verifying eligibility and membership status for the applicant.

___ The signed application must be stapled neatly together in this order:

___ Applicant Information Form

___ Signed Certification and Release Form

___ An official high school transcript

___ Typed, 500 - 1,000-word essay that responds to a provided CFCU prompt

___ One reference letter from a non-related community/church member, teacher, coach, boss, supervisor, family friend, etc.

___ All completed applications must be submitted on or before Friday, March 28, 2025, by 6:00pm to any Corry Federal Credit Union location to be considered.

Selection Process:

Judging is done by members from local organizations within the field of membership to create a fair and unbiased competition and will be based on both subjective criteria and weighted, objective criteria. These criteria areas include; completion of application, academic performance, essay, extracurricular and community activities, personal goals, length of credit union membership, and financial need.

Application Deadline:

All applications must be complete, in the order listed above and turned in, in person, no later than 6:00pm on Friday, March 28, 2025. Any late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
